Course will be held in the **103 Physiology Teaching Laboratory of the Gould Building (Building 116.103), Australian National University, ACT**. See maps attached.

This lab is on the lower level of the building (same level as Linnaeus Way entrance, downstairs from Daley Road entrance) next to reception. Signs will posted on the door.

The lab is approximately 1.5km from accommodation at the closest hotels (either Nishi or Novotel), but it is a pleasant 20 minute walk.

ANU requires enclosed shoes and masks to be worn in laboratories.

Course will start at 10.30 am Monday 20<sup>th</sup> June and finish at approximately 3pm Friday 24<sup>th</sup> June. Please advise if these times do not work for your flights. ANU is about 10 minutes by taxi from Canberra airport (\$25). If driving, please advise beforehand for parking instructions.


Morning and afternoon teas plus lunch provided: please advise dietary needs the week before. Other travel and accommodation to be covered by participants.
