




Surveillance and monitoring for plant pests, diseases and weeds.





- → Diagnostics ongoing


Monitoring updates





Exotic fruit fly

- → Highest detections of Oriental fruit fly ever recorded by NAQS
- → Bulk of detections on Badu Island
- → Incident Management Team stood up in October 2024
- → Fruit sanitation implemented for first time in the Torres Strait
