





- PNG hosted Solomon Islands (September 2024)
- Solomon Islands hosting PNG (planning underway June 2025)

Treaty Village Fruit Fly Trapping Program

- Commenced in 2022 to understand Oriental fruit fly population in the Treaty Villages of PNG
- Partnership between PNG, AU, INLOC and South Fly Rangers
- Proposing a trial of fruit fly management in Treaty Villages
 - PhD research through Australian Research Council
 in plant biosecurity, and James Cook University
 - Stakeholder engagement with Treaty Village community in Feb and June 2025
- Genetic analysis of fruit flies with AgriBio



PNG Twinning Program

- Three-year DFAT funded program (2024-2027)
- Goal:
 - Support PNG's capability to understand and manage biosecurity risks at the border, respond to animal disease and plant pest incursions and build biosecurity capabilities required for market access of agricultural products.



Activities:

- DAFF biosecurity specialist embedded within NAQIA
- Biosecurity system strengthening to enable NAQIA to better understand and manage biosecurity threats
- Building biosecurity preparedness and response capability for emergency animal diseases and plant pests

Timor-Leste Biosecurity Development Program



Three-year DFAT funded program (April 2023 - June 2026) to improve the consistency of the Timor-Leste biosecurity system by supporting collaboration on biosecurity and strengthening technical, operational and organisational capacity and capability.

Solomon Islands Biosecurity Development Program

- Collaboratively delivered with Biosecurity Solomon Islands (BSI)
- Established in 2013 currently in Phase 3
- Strengthens the capacity of BSI to prepare for, manage and respond to incursions of exotic pests and diseases. Focus on improving pre-border, border, and post-border processes.
